As we hear daily news reports of high grocery and gas prices, inflation, tariffs, talk of affordability, and the Strait of Hormuz closed, this is exactly the time to remind ourselves NOT to give those negative reports any power in our mind. We want to work to stay high-minded so we build a strong consciousness of abundance.

Charles Fillmore, Unity's co-founder, pointed out something remarkably interesting that we should all take a moment to consider when we think about growing our own consciousness. He invites us to think of the "rich kid."

He shared, "Those who are born and bred to riches usually have plenty all their lives even though they never make the effort to earn a dollar for themselves. This is because the ideas of plenty are so interwoven into their thought atmosphere that they are a very part of themselves. They have a consciousness of prosperity in which there is no idea of any condition under which the necessities of life could be lacking."

Here are a few thoughts to strengthen your consciousness of abundance. .

1. Prosperous people develop a prosperity mind-set.

Over the years you have cultivated certain habits and practices that are a part of how you live and view your life. Your prosperity (including your feelings about money) need not be weighed down by limiting thoughts. Your subconscious mind is programmed on how much abundance you will accept, and you must tell it how much you want to receive. In demonstrating increased prosperity, your belief must be accompanied by your personal concept of exactly how much abundance defines prosperity to you, because over time, your demonstration will come to be equivalent to your dominant belief. .

2. Prosperous people claim what they "do" want.

In Unity we teach that "life is consciousness" and there is no demonstration of your desire without first having the consciousness of the good to be demonstrated. When your vibration is not a match with your desired good, the good is there but you are not letting it in.

The thing that most interferes with matching your vibration to your good is the unconscious habit of thinking more about what you "don't" want than what you "do" want. As long as you think more about what you "don't" want, that is what you will attract. It is particularly important that you consciously distinguish between when you are holding the actual thought of having what you want compared to holding the thought of not having it, missing it, or wishing you had it!

3. Prosperous people are not afraid to think expansively.

Take your conscious mind way out beyond what you can believe is possible for your life. Lift into the realm of Divine Mind and stay there. It is like holding a muscle in a tight stretch that at first feels uncomfortable, but after a while your muscle relaxes to accommodate the stretch and you will begin to believe your vision is possible.

If the mental-equivalent you are holding is: "I can only have as much money as I need," or "It's not okay to have more than I need," you may be able to create more abundance, but you will also create more needs. As more abundance flows to you, your car might need an expensive repair, or your dog may need an expensive Vet treatment. Any extra money that comes to you will go toward something that is an emergency or a basic need because you have a mental equivalent that says, "I'll have only enough money to meet my needs."

It would be better to think big, spiritual life and affirm:

- I have abundant resources to pay for the things I love.

- I accept prosperity and abundance into my life now.

- I am abundance. . . abundance in financial resources, success, love, health... whatever I desire.

I encourage you to spend some time dwelling in the infinite universal supply of divine

substance and wrap your mind and heart around the largest concept you can!

A Little History of Mother's Day

From Global Peace to Greeting Cards, Julia Ward Howe, best known as the author of the "Battle Hymn of the Republic". Howe is also known as a women's rights advocate for peace. In 1870, horrified by the death and destruction of the Civil War, Howe issued what has come to be known as her "Mother's Day Proclamation". Appeal to womanhood throughout the world. In it, Howe urged the creation of an international body of women who could find ways to avoid war and bloodshed. The version of Mother's Day celebrated today is more rooted in the work of her daughter, Ann Jarvis, and granddaughter, Anna Jarvis. Later, her Granddaughter, Anna Jarvis, was instrumental in establishing a National Mother's Day on the second Sunday of May, the day her mother, Ann Maria Jarvis, died. Anna succeeded in her quest for official recognition when President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation of the first national Mother's Day just before the start of World War 1 in 1914. Anna chose a White carnation as the Emblem and urged people to write heartfelt letters of gratitude to their mothers.
