Monthly Message

Finding My Tribe Rev. Cherie Larkin

In the month of October I will be traveling to Sicily, Italy to meet the family of my birthfather. As an adopted child I never knew much about my biological parents. Adoption records in California are sealed, my adoptive parents never shared any information, and when I finally got enough information to search for my birth parents, both had passed away.

I did find and meet two brothers who grew up with my birthmother, and they were very generous with stories, photos, and even gave me some of her jewelry. All I learned about my birthfather, Sebastino Favara, was the information I gained from his death certificate which was minimal because he died deep in alcoholism and homeless.

To be relinquished to adoption makes an imprint on your soul. It's said an adopted child comes through the body of one woman into the heart of another. That was certainly true for me. I was fortunate to be adopted by loving parents who were thrilled to raise me and call me their own.

Still I spent 40 weeks growing inside a woman with her voice, heartbeat, scent etc. only to be born and handed off immediately to a woman with a different heartbeat, voice, scent etc. With no cognitive skills to process

what was happening, it was easy to develop an underlying feeling that perhaps there was something inherently wrong with me because I was not good enough to be kept.

Reframing that experience (which some call a primal wound) can take years. I don't think I'm alone in saying, an adopted child seems to always be looking (however consciously or unconsciously) for their "place" for their true home, looking for their tribe and the people to whom they really belong.

I never found any of my biological father's family and was at peace with that until one day via email I got a note from a man who said we might be a match on 23 and Me. It turned out he is my cousin and, while he lives in San Francisco and his son lives in Rocklin, neither has any interest in meeting or pursuing our connection. But, my new-found cousin did refer me to some relatives in Italy who he said were looking for me. What? Looking for me?

My birthfather left Italy when he was 18 and never looked back or made contact with his family again. His younger brother, Salvatore, always wondered what happened to the older brother he loved, but sadly Salvatore died without ever finding his brother

again. Now Salvatore's great grand kids and grandnephews have been on a mystery hunt to find out what happened to their great Uncle Sebastino. As it turns out, I am what happened to him. I am his daughter; and my niece Ashley is his granddaughter; and her new baby, Siena; is his great granddaughter.

The ZOOM connections started, and they were filled with primal energies of connection, raw emotions of immeasurable joy, love, and good will. To be embraced by a Sicilian family is a bit like a scene out of the movie, My Big Fat Greek Wedding. Ashley, Siena, and I are traveling to Sicily to meet our family who have lived in the same town in Lentini, Sicily since before 1820!

I invite you to keep me in your prayers for divine love and order. And to say a prayer for any child who has ever experienced the loss of a parent from whatever cause. May their hearts always know their value and worth.


