The 12 powers is one of Unity's most unique teachings. They are twelve spiritual aspects of Divine Mind that were named and defined by Charles Fillmore as the full complement of energy centers Jesus engaged in his consciousness to become the Christ.

Lastly is Renewing or Releasing the Relationship. This includes a decision to continue a relationship with the person involved, or release the relationship. It is stressed that it should not be considered a failure to release a relationship.

Rev. Tutu equates this process to the stages of grief. He makes the point that "you don't go through the steps sequentially, nor do you necessarily go through them in a single short time frame." Of course new information, changes in the situation, or even a shift in your feeling about an event can move you forward or backward on your path.

"Ultimately, forgiveness is a grace and a goodness we offer to ourselves," Rev. Tutu explains, not a gift we give someone else. Forgiveness is an act of empowerment, not of weakness or vulnerability. He stresses, "Without forgiveness, we remain tethered to the person who harmed us. We are bound with chains of bitterness, tied together, trapped. Until we can forgive the person who harmed us, they will hold the keys to our happiness, they will be our jailer." The book gives evidence that forgiving heals us not just spiritually, but physically, emotionally and mentally.

I loved the explanation of ubuntu a Bantu term that is loosely defined as "humanity", or the understanding that we are who we are through one another. Part of this is the concept that any pain, any grief, affects us all--and that it is preferable to focus on the ways we are all alike, instead of emphasizing how we are different. Ultimately, we are more alike than we are different. "Forgiveness is nothing less than how we bring peace to ourselves and our world," the archbishop tells us.

May we all be graced with the blessing of true forgiveness, for ourselves, and for others we have encountered.

We had our annual meeting on February 26th. It was well-attended with lots of useful information and many questions were asked and answered.

The first order of business was the election of new Board members. The Board had temporarily appointed Michel Lawson, Donal Smith and Sally Smock to serve until the annual meeting. At the meeting, each was elected to a 3-year term by unanimous consent. We were sorry to say goodbye to Trustee, Dave Langley who resigned his seat effective February 26th. Dave has served on the Board for five years and headed the team that did the Minister search. He will remain an active member of the church.

Patty gave an update on the things the Board is working on for the future and Rev. Cherie reviewed our 2022 goals and shared the truly remarkable progress we made. The Board will be meeting shortly to finalize the goals for 2023.

Natalie presented the 2023 budget and provided a comparison to the 2022 budget noting that more funds are being budgeted for marketing and advertising – especially in the social media space. In addition, more was budgeted for music as we work to integrate the music into the new order of service and use it to build energy and feelings of inclusion among those in attendance. Natalie also noted a significant decrease in the budget for technology and software. Lots of funds were designated for this in 2022 and we have gone a long way toward updating our hardware, equipment and software. Going forward, funding will concentrate on software licensing fees and renewals.

Another item on the agenda was the adoption of new bylaws. With one amendment, the revised bylaws were adopted by unanimous consent. The new bylaws call for members to renew their commitment and membership annually. Those who attended the meeting did so. For those who did not attend the meeting, watch for a mailing with a membership renewal form. The form must be completed and either placed in the basket at the back of the sanctuary or returned by mail within 30 days the mailing date. The Board and Rev. Cherie are so grateful to all of you who are so generous with you time, talent and treasure in support of our ministry. We look forward to a dynamic, fun and rewarding 2023.


