Holding the High Watch

The theme for the 2022 Unity World Day of Prayer is “Holding the High Watch”. The first image that pops into my head when I hear that phrase is of a lookout tower atop a mountain with someone searching in 360-degree fashion for danger. The watcher has a responsibility to sense if anything is amiss and take action if there is. She is perched above the fray and has the advantage of seeing the whole picture. She can pinpoint where trouble may be brewing and work to address it at the source. This image is a perfect metaphor for holding the high watch Unity style. Let’s explore this.

Charles Fillmore writes in The Atom Smashing Power of Mind that “holding the high watch is our ability to slip into the state of silence, beyond thoughts, upholding the truth for those with whom we pray”. In Effective Prayer, Francis Foulkes writes “The secret of the manifestation of all the good we need and desire is in the high watch, the lifted vision. Our vision can only be lifted... by being filled with high and holy thoughts and by our holding fast to these until the eye becomes swift and single to the good only”. These ideas make it clear that the process for holding the high watch is focused on prayer – both for ourselves and for others. Since I cannot effectively pray for others if I am not spiritually fit myself, it stands to reason that holding the high watch starts with me.

As the watcher it is up to me to identify areas of potential trouble. This requires me to get in touch with both the physical and spiritual parts of me, to identify any looming “hot spots” and seek guidance for resolving whatever comes to mind. As I fine tune the relationship between God and me, I improve my ability to spot trouble in others. I am better able to intuitively recognize a distress signal coming from a friend or colleague. When this happens, I can stop immediately and affirm the highest good for all and, if appropriate, offer a helping hand. But holding the high watch doesn’t stop there. Each day in my daily time of prayer and meditation I uphold the truth, reaffirm that God, good is everywhere present in my life and the lives of all around me. As the watcher, God expresses Divine Order and right outcomes through me.

In closing, I offer this prayer from Linda Martella Whitsett, VP of Prayer Ministry, Unity Village:

With an inward and upward gaze, I rise from human concerns so that I might revel in the indwelling Spirit. I take my place in the seat of prayer, in the radiance of divine light. I hold the high watch for all people, knowing the truth of oneness and wholeness.

I am one with divine love that lifts the sorrowful and suffering. I am one with divine life by which they heal.

I am one with divine wisdom that beams like a lighthouse, shining light on their path ahead.

My eyes of faith have a view of the horizon up here on the mountaintop of awareness. I wait, watchfully. I view the fulfillment of dreams and intentions for me and for all those with whom I pray, without obstruction and in a state of expectancy. My vision is far reaching as I hold the high watch. I say, “Amen, let it be. And so it is.”


